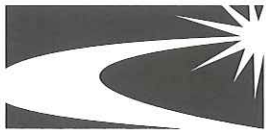

Dear Mr. Carter:

I am writing to confirm a prior e-mail communication in which the Los Angeles City Attorneys' Association (LACAA) indicated its desire to meet and confer over the effects or practical consequences of the Office's furlough plan. LACAA formally requests to begin the meet and confer process. We would like to schedule a meeting as soon as possible because time is of the essence with respect to certain issues.

At this point in time, we are particularly concerned about the scheduling of furlough hours at certain branch offices. We also have concerns over time recording aspects related to the furlough plan. There may be additional issues by the time we meet.

I must stress that our request to meet and confer over the effects of the furlough should not be construed as a waiver by LACAA of its position as to the legality or appropriateness of the furloughs.
